



SARASOTA'S CONTEMPORARY THEATRE

THEATRE AND PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Florida Studio Theatre (FST) has been in operation in Sarasota since 1973. During its history, **FST** has grown into a theatre with an annual budget of over \$4 million and nearly 25,000 subscribers a year, more than any theatre its size in the country.

FST operates three theatres, the 173 seat Keating Mainstage Theatre, the 160 seat Gompertz Theatre and the 109 seat Goldstein Cabaret Theatre.

FST produces world premieres and contemporary works which have been produced on or off-Broadway within the last five years. By focusing on the works of contemporary writers, **FST** has been able to offer plays to its audience that are not usually produced by other area theatres. **FST** is comprised of six main programs: Mainstage, Cabaret, The Gompertz Theatre, Education, Touring, and New Play Development.

FST has an extensive Education Wing which offers over 20 classes weekly, **FST's** touring company reaches over 50,000 students annually in the Southeastern United States and beyond, inspiring them to write plays for **FST's** annual Young Playwrights' Festival.

The New Play Development Program is an integral part of **Florida Studio Theatre** and its mission. **FST** receives over 8,000 plays a year from established, emerging, and young writers. Many new scripts developed through this program reach the Mainstage and Cabaret Theatre stages.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Florida Studio Theatre offers internships in the following areas:

Production/Company Management

Assist the Company Manager and Production Manager in Guest Relations (communicating with performers, assist with travel and housing), research, shop needs and provide general clerical support for the department.

Marketing

Assist with writing press releases, design of marketing materials, direct mail campaigns and other support. Secondary duty in Front-of-House.

Development

Research grants and grant prospects, assist with special events, small gift campaigns, direct mail campaigns and other support. Secondary duty in Front-of-House.

Literary Management

Gain experience in Literary Management and New Play Development. Writing opportunities possible. Secondary duties in Front-of-House.

Stage Management

Assist in rehearsals and running shows under the Equity Stage Manager's supervision. **FST** produces numerous shows every year under the Mainstage, Stage III, Cabaret, Children's and New Play Development Programs.

Costuming

Running wardrobe, costume construction, some maintenance and other support.

Design Assistant

Work with professional designers in their field and have the possibility for some assistant design or design work. Secondary duties in scenic or costume construction and show running.

Lighting

Work with the Master Electrician on maintaining Lighting Inventory, hang and focus, maintenance on shows and special projects as assigned.

Sound

Have the opportunity to learn and operate the Yamaha digital sound console during production and operate the SFX computerized sound playback system. Work with the production team on locating and creating sound cues for production and other support as assigned.

Carpentry

Work directly with the TD and designers on set construction, strike, load-in, scenic painting, and show running and maintenance

Education Assistant – assist the Associate Director, Tour booking manager and serve as teaching artist or assistant teaching artist.

Artistic Assistant – assist the Casting & Hiring Coordinator and Artistic Director with casting prep, hiring prep, scheduling, production sound research, special projects and general clerical support.

Acting Internship – perform in children’s shows, understudy Mainstage shows and work part time in another area of the Theatre. (Audition required).
